Don Mills Documentary screening Saturday, May 2nd, 2009, at 7 p.m.

"**Changing the Winds of Change**," a documentary on Don Mills and the effects of the redevelopment on the community, will be screened this **Saturday, May 2nd, at 7 p.m. at St. Mark's Presbyterian Church** at 1 Greenland Road (at The Donway East). Produced by a young Don Mills resident, who was the outspoken "high school student" quoted in an [April 2006 Toronto Star article by Joe Fiorito](#), the documentary includes interviews with Don Mills residents who are passionate about their community and concerned about its future. The producer also intends the documentary to offer a look at the process of how citizens can go about changing and influencing developers' plans.

The 10-minute documentary, which was produced with assistance from the Toronto Youth Documentary workshop series run by the National Film Board and founded by a mentorship producer from Discovery Channel, will be screened as part of a variety show that also includes performances of music, art, and poetry, as well as two other short films. Refreshments will be served during the intermission. The show is a fundraiser for the youth group's performers, who will be going to Canada Youth 2009. A portion of the proceeds will also go to charity.
